## Quiltfest 2017 Meeting Minutes - September 3, 2016

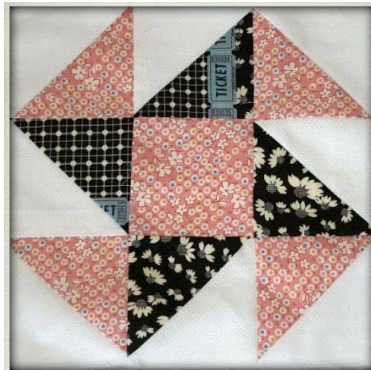
1. Chair Dottie Atkins opened the meeting at 10:00 am. The June minutes were accepted as written.
2. Dottie has the application for the Convention Center marquee and the cost lists. There are no increases for 2017. The concessions will be open on both days. Dottie will confirm the minimum sales required. The poles have been reserved and there will be thirty black drapes for the poles. Dottie will check on the show insurance.
3. We have the contract from AETN for the seven ads we wish to run. There will be two in April, three in June, and two in July. Paula Abney will check the wording as we will need the April wording to include that entry form submissions must be made by May 1st. Paula has also put together a flyer for our website and for distribution to other guilds. Dottie will coordinate with her on the final version.
4. Betty Smith will handle the Quilts of Valor display for the show.
5. We need a coordinator for the signs and easels. The signs will include the "Do Not Touch" for the hall and those with directions to Hall 'A' that will be placed at the center's entrances. LaDawanna Prestage has volunteered for this job.
6. Sharron Hord gave a treasurer's report. Eddie Landreth will deliver the Silent Auction quilt at our October guild meeting. Sharron has spoken to a state contact about handling taxes. We will be able to combine the door and Boutique incomes to calculate the taxes that will be due each day.
7. It was decided that the Silent Auction quilt will be located just passed the Boutique in the center area. The memorial area for Jackie Peake and Diana Perry will also be located in the center. Dottie will get a volunteer or two to coordinate the memorials.
8. A number of suggestions were made for program book ads. One was to place more emphasis on cafes and restaurants. It was also suggested that we consider contacting the Visit Hot Springs office and Oaklawn.
9. Wilma Blair, Carol Frazier, and Betty Williams are handling taking in the quilts. They will need four workers to carry the entries to the appropriate rows for hanging. There was some discussion about sleeves. It was decided that, with the exception of Category 9, no entries will be accepted without sleeves. The acknowledgement letters will contain a statement that we will no longer accept entries without sleeves and will not provide any.
10. The judges will need four scribes. We are finalizing the judging forms and will send them to the judges for approval.
11. Carol Swigart reported that we have five confirmed vendors. She will be sending reminder cards to the other vendors.
12. Dottie will confirm the Garland County library meeting room for 2017. Our next committee meeting will be October 1, 2016 at 10:00 am. The meeting was adjourned at 11:10 am.

# Block of the Month

## SEPTEMBER BLOCK-OF-THE-MONTH -- PERPETUAL MOTION

Colors: Pink and Black on Neutral Background



<FRONT Unfinished: 12-1/2" sq  
Simple 9-Patch with Half-Square Triangles

### HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLES:

BACKGROUND: Four (4) 5" squares

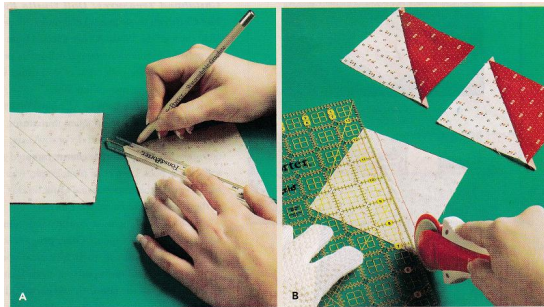
PINK (or medium color of your choice): Two (2) 5" squares

**PLUS** One (1) 4-1/2" square for Center

BLACK (or dark): Two (2) 5" squares

Match a 5-inch Background square with each of the two Pink and two Black 5-inch squares, right sides together. On background fabric, mark line across one diagonal corner to corner. Sew 1/4" seam on each side of line on each color set. Cut down the middle on diagonal mark.

Press to dark side, and **trim to 4-1/2-inch squares**.



Lay out nine-patches as pictured above (top) alternating pink and black triangle squares using the Pink 4-1/2" square at Center. Sew rows together using 1/4" seam, matching intersections. Press.

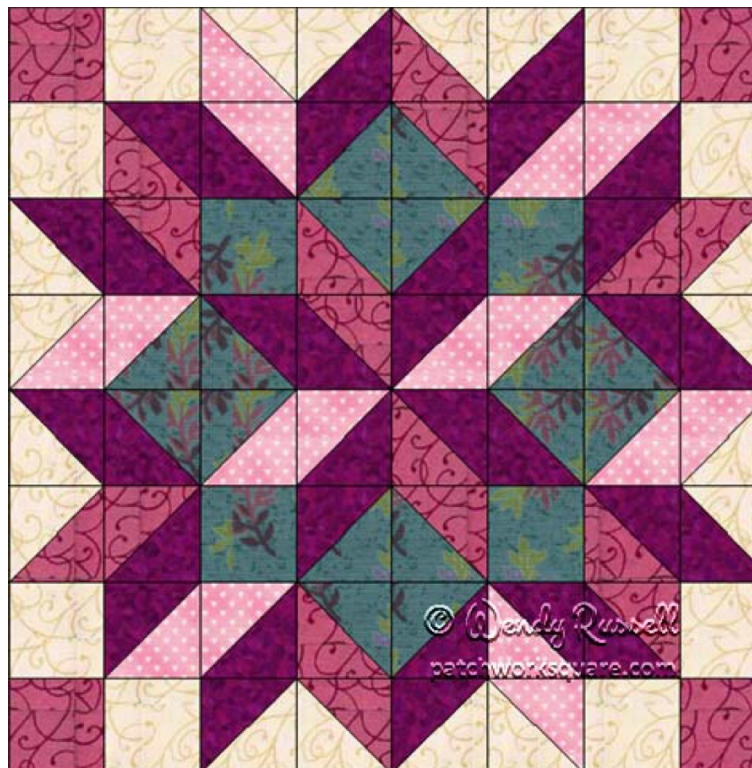
